

Installing CLIQS on Windows


System Requirements

Item	Required	Recommended
Operating System	Windows 8.1 64bit	Windows 10 Professional 64bit

Installation Process

- 1. Download and install Microsoft .NET 6 Desktop Runtime for x64:
 - https://dotnet.microsoft.com/en-us/download/dotnet/6.0
- 2. Download and Install Microsoft Visual C++ x64 re-distributable:
 - https://www.microsoft.com/enus/download/confirmation.aspx?id=52685&6B49FDFB-8E5B-4B07-BC31-15695C5A2143=1
- 3. Run the MSI installer included in this distribution
- 4. Launch the app from the desktop shortcut or the icon in the start menu

Licensing



NOTE: Launching Configure License UI

In the following guides, we'll often instruct you to "launch the *Configure License* tool", to do this:

- Launch CLIQS
- Click Yes on the Licensing message box that appears

To run the app, you must provide your activation key and allow the system to perform a one-time activation from our license server.

- Launch the Configure License tool
- Enter your activation key into the Acquire License field and click Acquire
- Close the configure license window

Delegated Licensing

License activation requires an active internet connection. If this is not available we can use a fallback where another machine that does have internet access can process the activation request as a proxy.

Let's call the target, offline machine, *PC1* and the support machine that has internet access *PC2*.

Start on *PC1*:

- Launch the Configure License tool
- Enter your activation key into the activation id field
- Check the *Delegate* box
- Click Acquire
- Save the request file to your desktop
- Send the request file somehow to PC2 (USB stick, email, etc.)

Move to PC2:

- Install CLIQS
 - NOTE: CLIQS can be uninstalled from the 2nd machine after this process is complete and it will not require, or consume a license
- Launch the Configure License tool
- Click Browse in the Delegated Activation section
- Select the activation request file from PC1
- Click Process
- Notice a new file, the response file, is generated alongside the request file
- Send the response file to *PC1*
- Uninstall CLIQS (if necessary)

Back on PC1:

- Launch the Configure License tool
- Click *Browse* in the *Delegated Activation* section
- Locate and open the processed response file
- Click Integrate
- Close the configure license window
